



## JLCNB 2018 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

### OUR MISSION STATEMENT

The JLCNB is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving communities through effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.

### ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicants must be U.S. citizens.
- B. Applicants must be high school seniors, graduating in the Spring of 2018.
- C. Applicants shall attend a public or private high school or be home schooled in Brevard County but must reside in Central or Northern Brevard County.
- D. Applicants must be accepted to attend an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or university in the United States as a full-time student with a goal of earning an undergraduate degree at a 4-year institution or an associate degree at a 2-year institution.
- E. Both male and female students are eligible.
- F. Immediate family members of a Junior League member are ineligible.

### TERMS

- A. The scholarships will be paid directly to the recipient's college/university or directly to the recipient, whichever the JLCNB deems most appropriate. Monetary award will follow verification of college/university enrollment.

### SELECTION OF RECIPIENT

- A. The scholarships shall be awarded to candidates demonstrating voluntarism in school and/or community. Leadership and achievement are also considered.
- B. Only one application per student will be accepted. Scholarships will be awarded to the two most qualified students as determined by the JLCNB Scholarship Committee.
- C. The decision of the Scholarship Committee shall be final.

### APPLICATION INFORMATION

- A. **Deadline for receipt of the application is April 1, 2018.**
- B. Award notification will take place in May, 2018.
